If you could work with any entrepreneur, who would it be? And why? I have not yet to find them. Let's create soon!


If you were talking to a younger version of you, what advice would you give yourself? Be a overseer focus and study to create your biggest reality.

What's your biggest accomplishments so far? My biggest accomplishment was getting a check from music cuz I started off out the trunk selling CDs.


